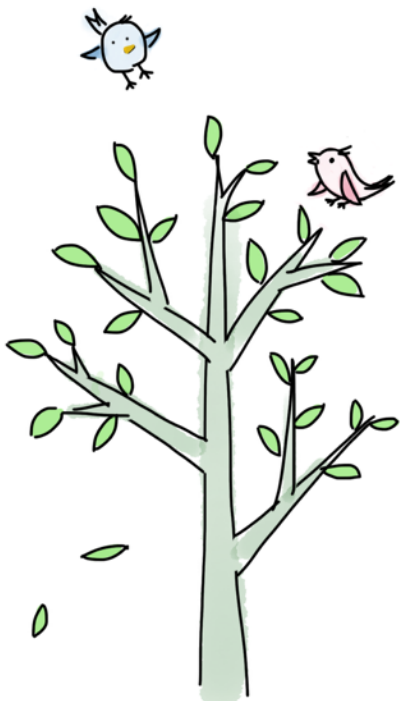


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Level 1
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This English version of the Juego en Español challenge is to help parents and caregivers understand the instructions on the Spanish version, or for children learning English to practice speaking skills.

Summer Challenge:
When you finish an activity, color the corresponding square.



Count the steps from your bed to the bathroom.	Find 3 things bigger than you are and 3 things smaller than you are	Record yourself (audio or video) counting. Then listen to it.	Talk to a pet or stuffed animal. Say 3 things about yourself.
Find 3 things that are soft and 3 things that are hard.	Open a closet and name 3 things.	In the kitchen, find 3 foods that you like. Name them saying "I like..."	Name and act out 3 animals.
Look at a map or a globe. Name 3 Spanish-speaking countries.	Spin in circles saying "I'm spinning." Spin fast saying "I'm spinning fast." Spin slowly saying "I'm spinning slowly."	On a map of South America, follow the outline of 3 countries with your finger. Name them.	Say the vowels - a, e, i, o, u. Say them loudly. Say them softly. Say them in a happy voice. Say them in a sad voice.
Choose 2 rooms in your house. Count all the chairs in those rooms.	Draw a house using 5 different colors. Name the colors.	Go outside and look for 3 black things and 3 white things.	Wash your hands and say "I'm washing my hands" 3 times as you do it.
