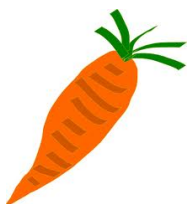
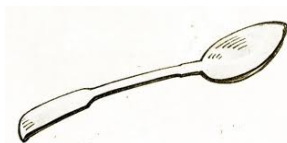
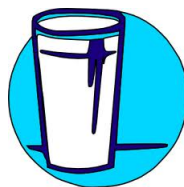
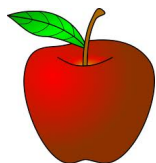
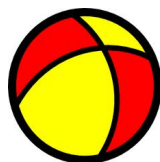
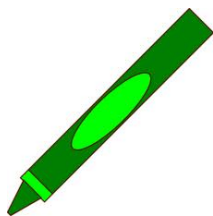


## Inside scavenger hunt with picture clues

This is a scavenger hunt for beginning Spanish learners. It uses picture clues, so the children do not have to read. I have included a version with labeled pictures, too.

With scavenger hunts that use picture clues, you have to tell the kids if the picture is a symbol (they can find any ball, any t-shirt, any shoe), or if they have to find the color or type in the picture. For example, my students learn *dinero* before *moneda* or any other specific money words, so any kind of money works for that clue.
