Describing Activity

Number of Players: one or more.

Materials Needed: vocabulary picture cards

Instructions:

- Give each student or pair of students a set of vocabulary picture cards.
- Write on the board a comparison question, like:
 - ¿Es grande o pequeño/a? = Is it big or small?
- Write on the board an example answer, like:
 - Es grande. = It's big.
- Students should put their picture cards in a pile face down.
- They should turn one card over at a time and say the sentence that indicates what group the picture belongs in.
- You can have more than two groups if you choose. Just be sure to add extra groups to your comparison question, like:
 - ¿Es grande, pequeño/a, o bonito/a? = Is it big, small, or pretty?
- If students are working in pairs, have them alternate picking up cards. The person who does not pick up a card will ask the question, and the other person will answer and place the card in its group.

Variation:

- You can make this activity more kinesthetic by taping up group names spread out on the wall in your room.
- Then give each student one picture.
- Ask the question to everyone: ¿Es grande, pequeño/a, o bonito/a? for each picture.
- Everyone answers, and the student with that picture goes and stands where the group name is.
- If your students are not in agreement about the group, then take a vote to decide.
