



Memory – you can play alone or with a partner.

- Make a pair of cards for each vocabulary word. Each card should have the Spanish word or picture on it on one side only.
- Turn the cards upside down on a table and mix them up.
- Arrange the cards in several rows face down.
- Take turns turning two cards face up. Say each one aloud, and see if they match. If they do, keep the pair. If not, turn them back facedown.
- Continue turning up pairs of cards until you match them all.
- The player with the most matches wins.

Ideas for making different types of memory card pairs:

- One card has the picture and the other has the word in Spanish.
- One card has the Spanish word and the other has the English word.
- Both cards have a picture only of the word. This is good if you have learned the new words and want to test yourself without seeing a written word.

You can also use your memory cards to play a game of **Go Fish**.
