

Silly Run on Sentences:

Number of Players: 1 or more

Materials Needed: vocabulary picture cards - one set for your whole group, one set for each person, **or** one set for each pair/small group **Instructions**:

- Give each pair or small group a set of picture cards to lay on the table face up.
- Write on the board these connector words with English meaning if needed:

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porque = becausey = andcuando = whencon = withen = in, on, at
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- One person begins the sentence by using the word for one of the picture cards.
- The next person continues the sentence using another picture card.
- They continue until they have used all their cards.
- You may want them to write their sentence too to share with the class.
- You may want to do this activity together once so that students see how to do it. Show them how to use the connector words to keep their sentence going.
- You also may want to discuss what a run on sentence is and how they are not grammatically correct, but can be fun for an activity like this.

Variations:

- Playing as a whole group, give each person a card. Go around the room with each person adding a piece to the sentence using his/her word.
- Doing individually, give each person a set of cards so he/she can write a silly run on sentence. Then let students read their sentence to a friend or the class.
