



Spanish for You!
Simple. Effective. Affordable

¿Qué te gusta? Card Activity

Number of Players: 2 or more.

Materials Needed: index cards, pencil, or vocabulary picture cards
(see game variation below)

Instructions:

- To save on cards, cut index cards in half.
- Write on cards things you like - for example: el suéter, las manzanas, el espantapájaros, la mochila, etc.
- Write on more cards things you may like to do - for example: leer, patinar sobre el hielo, hacer chocolate caliente, mirar la televisión, comer pizza, etc.
- Turn cards face down on the table.
- Players take turns picking up a card and asking the player next to him, "¿Te gusta(n)_____?" filling in with what is on the card.
- The player answers either "Sí, me gusta(n)____." or "No, no me gusta(n)_____." filling in with what is on the card.
- Continue play until all cards have been used.

Activity Variation:

- One player read the sentence: Me gusta(n)_____. (filling in blank with each of the cards)
- Any player who likes it stands up.
- Players continue sitting or standing depending on if they like or dislike what is read.

Another Variation:

Make your draw pile out of **vocabulary pictures** only so that players have to think about how to say each in Spanish.
