Simón Dice (Simon Says)

Two or more players:

Materials: vocabulary picture cards (optional)

Instructions:

- Choose a person to be Simón.
- Simón gives commands to the other players telling them what to do.
- The other players do as Simón commands, BUT Simón has to say "Simón Dice" (Simon Says) before each command.
 - **Example:** "Simón Dice escribe con el lápiz." (Simon Says write with the pencil.)
- If Simón gives a command without saying "Simón Dice" first, then the players should not do it. Any player that does it is out.
- The last player still in gets to be Simón.

*You may want to establish gestures to show each command before playing. For example, to show the word "coge" (which means "pick"), you may establish a gesture of showing someone picking an apple from a tree.

**This is a great activity to do while introducing new vocabulary and verb commands and as a class warm-up.

Variation:

Let students play in small groups. Write the commands on the board and give each group a set of vocabulary picture cards to help Simón say sentences and players understand.

Dice (Dee-say)
