## Language notes for Batalla de Tamaños (Country cards)

### Articles

A few countries that appear on the cards can be used with a definite article: el Perú, el Canadá, la India, la Argentina, los Estados Unidos, el Japón, el Brasil. Whether or not the article is used varies with context and region, but according to the RAE the use of the article is optional. There are examples of these countries used with and without the article in the sentences in the post.

### Numbers

You do not have to say the area of the countries to play the game. If you do, this information may be helpful. The numbers in the game are being used as adjectives, describing *millas cuadradas* (square miles). In Spanish, all parts of a number that can agree with the gender of a noun should agree. So, the hundreds and ones places will show agreement with the feminine noun *millas*. You say *El Perú tiene **cuartocientas** noventa y seis mil, **doscientas** veinticinco millas cuadradas*. You say *Kenia tiene **doscientas** veinticuatro mil, **ochenta y una** millas cuadradas*

Large numbers take practice in any language. Here are a few more examples from the cards:

Canadá

3,855,100 mi<sup>2</sup> - Tres millones, ochocientos cincuenta y cinco mil, cien millas cuadradas

Estados Unidos

3,717,813 mi<sup>2</sup> - Tres millones, setecientos diecisiete mil, ochocientos trece millas cuadradas.

México

758,449 mi<sup>2</sup> - Setecientos cincuenta y ocho mil, cuatrocientas cuarenta y nueve millas cuadradas.
