

This English version of the Juego en Español challenge is to help parents and caregivers understand the instructions on the Spanish version. It can also be used with children learning English.

Summer Challenge:

When you finish an activity, color the corresponding square.

Look in a mirror and describe what you see.	Name as many animals as you can.	Find a picture of a person and name the body parts.	Bounce a ball or toss it in the air 20 times, counting out loud.
Write your name and say the letters.	In salt, sand, or the dirt, write the word sal, arena or tierra. Then, write 3 more words.	Choose a sentence from a story and sing it.	Look in the refrigerator. Close the door and name as many foods as you can remember.
Count the doors or windows in your house.	Sit under a table and name 5 foods you like.	Find 3 things that are red and 3 things that are blue.	Describe the clothes you are wearing.
Walk backwards saying "I'm walking backwards." Walk forward saying "I'm walking forward."	Count backward from 20 to 0.	Draw a happy face, a sad face, and an angry face. Say happy, sad and angry in that tone of voice.	Draw a monster and describe it.
