


Summer Challenge:

When you finish an activity, color the corresponding square.



This English version of the Juego en Español challenge is to help parents and caregivers understand the instructions on the Spanish version, or for children learning English to practice speaking skills.

Count the steps from your bed to the mailbox.	Find and name 3 things bigger than you are and 3 things smaller than you are.	Record yourself (audio or video) saying 2 sentences from a story. Then listen to it.	Talk to a pet or stuffed animal. Say 5 things about yourself.
Find and name 3 things that are soft and 3 things that are hard.	Open a closet and name as many things as you can.c	In the kitchen, find 5 foods that you like. Name them saying "I like"	Name and act out 5 animals.
Look at a map or a globe. Name 5 Spanish-speaking countries.	Spin in circles saying "I'm spinning." Spin fast saying "I'm spinning fast." Spin slowly saying "I'm spinning slowly."	On a map of South America, follow the outline of 3 countries with your finger. Name them and say which is the biggest and which is the smallest.	Say the vowels - a, e, i, o, u. Say them loudly. Say them softly. Say them in a happy voice. Say them in a sad voice.
Count all the chairs in your house.	Draw a house using 5 different colors. Name the colors and the parts of the house.	Go outside and look for 3 black things, 3 white things and 3 gray things.	Wash your hands and say "I'm washing my hands with soap and water" 3 times as you do it.
